Communities first

I believe in community politics; in the power of local people to come together to solve problems and make their neighbourhood better. As your MP I will continue to represent local people on issues that matter to all of us: NHS, environment, housing, education, transport, crime and council services. Beckenham needs an MP who will work hard in Westminster to bring about change to help local people. I will put our community first.

As a community champion I have a track record in Beckenham on local issues. A recent example was my successful lobbying of Southeastern for the return of the Beckenham Junction to Blackfriars train service that was stopped during COVID; and my continued pressure on Network Rail got the footbridge reinstated. I also successfully won a £20k grant for improvements on Beckenham Green, and last year a £16K grant to set up an annual cultural event that promotes young people in music.

Make government accountable again

The last few years have shown just how broken politics and the government are. Bad decision after bad decision is made and yet no one is ever held accountable – it seems as though Ministers can do whatever they want with zero consequence. This must change. As your MP I will fight to bring back some integrity to parliament and campaign for more accountability. I will work hard to scrutinise government proposals to avoid bad decisions and get the best outcomes for our community.

Problem-solving our biggest challenges

Time and time again many of us find ourselves in disbelief that the latest government-made problem could not have been predicted and avoided with common sense. There are too many examples of ill-conceived projects and policies being poorly managed and suffering from costly consequences. Not to mention ideological decisions made by Ministers that do not put people first. Meanwhile service providers turn a healthy profit. Government needs a new approach to solve the challenges we face and MPs cannot continue to accept second-rate solutions - they must demand better.
