Tackling crime to keep you safe:

Campaigning for community police hubs and to keep the police on our streets.

2

Build up our local parties:

Increasing our existing team assisting Camden councillors and building a strong team in the Haringey party, so we can raise funds and improve results in future local elections.

Fighting for Funds at the Royal Free Hospital:

Over a decade of Conservative mismanagement has led to an endemic pest infestation at the Royal Free NHS Trust. Blaise will hold Labour to account to fix this and he will always be your local champion fighting for our NHS.

Standing up for Hampstead & Highgate:

• Housing

Blaise will scrutinise the proposed redevelopment of the O2 Centre into high-rise flats. Enough of these new flats must be affordable and the reconstruction mustn't disrupt the community's character or be built without the consent of the local community.

• Traffic

Traffic congestion, particularly on major roads like Finchley Road and West End Lane, is a pressing issue. Blaise's previous campaign gave him plenty of experience in dealing with the introduction of measures like ULEZ and Clean Air Zones. Blaise will hold the relevant parties to account and ensure that a proper nuanced solution is found that it's in the interests of the whole constituency.

• Cost of Living

Blaise will fight for greater increased investment in public services, including the Royal Free Hospital and the West Hampstead police station.



Blaise's bio:

- After working in the European Parliament during the Brexit years, Blaise returned to London to work in the Department for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (DEFRA).
- There he worked in communications, advising farmers and land managers on how to financially cope following the loss of their EU subsidy payments, while also sticking to climate friendly practices.
- While running in two separate elections, he worked for a broadcast agency, securing media coverage for farmers coping with the devastating impact of climate change, e.g. at least one storm per month for the past 18 months.
- He now works in EU policy and can use his experience media, government and frontline politics to run a strong campaign in Hampstead and Highgate.
