Application to be your Prospective Parliamentary Candidate for Hampstead and Highgate

My name is Riad Mannan and I am applying to be your parliamentary candidate for Hampstead and Highgate.

I believe I have the right mix of experience, energy, and enthusiasm to lead, and front, a campaign for a Liberal Democrat option on the ballot paper, whenever the election is called.

As a pre-requisite for that campaign, I will help, support and spearhead a campaign to establish our party as the main alternative to Labour; activate existing members and recruit new ones, help raise funds for current and future fights and lead campaigns on local and national issues.



My political background: Whilst I have always been a centrist, for transparency I was a member of the Labour party for many years till I joined the Liberal Democrats in 2019. This was based on their stance on the Iraq war, Europe, and antisemitism - and my own political alignment in the centre and my desire for a fairer, more tolerant society - which I believe only the Liberal Democrats embody and can deliver. I believe my political journey, and the reasons for it, can be a strong story to tell Labour supporters in Hampstead and Highgate who may be feeling buyer's remorse in this Labour government and this Labour MP.

Since joining the party I have been an executive member, stood as a paper candidate in council elections, was an agent for elections and by-elections, was the PPC in Harlow at the last General Election, and a Lead Steward at Conference.

Why I am standing: Put simply, because I want to help people live their best lives; with LibDem policies that have a positive impact on their lives, with a listening ear to hear their concerns, and provide practical solutions to their challenges. In Hampstead & Highgate, whilst I recognise I am an outsider, I believe I have the right skills, temperament and drive to challenge the current MP on policies, and campaign hard, engage voters, community groups and local networks to provide a real alternative on election day.

Personal Story: I was born in South London to parents from Bangladesh and I am proud of my Asian heritage. After graduating as a Civil Engineer, I worked on various project (from A20, Heathrow Express and Jubilee Line Extension) before switching careers to become a Conference Content Producer. I moved to Dubai and lived there for 10 years before returning in 2016, and currently live in Stevenage, Hertfordshire with my wife and daughter.

My campaign priorities as your candidate:

Whilst there are, and always will be, a range of issues to deal with, if I am selected, I will campaign on local and national issues, including, but not limited to:

- **Supporting local campaigners and councillors** in their effort to oppose the revised planning application for the former Homebase / O2 Car Park site
- **Providing a proactive voice to tackle local crime**, anti-social behaviour and improve homelessness services, especially in light of LibDem budget amendments being rejected by Labour
- **Working constructively with stakeholders** to ensure there is improved housing affordability in the area, both for homeowners and renters
- **Holding the current Labour MP to account** on her voting record, whether on the heartless winter fuel payment cuts or the job-destroying National Insurance tax hike
