A STRONGER OPPOSITION

Lib Dems more than double their number of Councillors on Ealing Council to a record 13 - holding Labour to account



The strengthened Liberal Democrat Official Opposition team will continue to **stand up for you** on Ealing Council.

The Liberal Democrats have doubled their Official Opposition team, having won seats from both Labour and the Conservatives.

Here in Ealing Broadway ward, local people have elected a Liberal Democrat as their local Councillor for the first time in history.

Adam Keenan is now your new Liberal Democrat Councillor - defeating the sitting Conservative by **17 votes**.

His running mates **Francesco Fruzza and Mandy Lurie** narrowly lost by less than 85 and 185 votes respectively - with Green and Labour

candidates trailing far behind.

With his professional background as a teacher, **Adam** will also serve as the new local Lib Dems' Children's Services and Education spokesperson.

Newly elected **Councillor Adam Keenan** says, "Thank you to the local people who have put their trust in me. **The Lib Dems will continue to hold Ealing Labour to account and stand up for you.**"

"We will continue to fight for cleaner streets, safer communities, efficient use of your Council Tax, and campaign for people to have a say in local decision-making."

ADAM SPEAKS OUT FOR LOCAL PEOPLE IN HIS MAIDEN SPEECH

New Lib Dem Councillor Adam Keenan wastes no time and immediately sets his priorities in his maiden speech at July's first Full Council meeting since the local elections.

Councillor Adam Keenan reiterated residents' concerns directly to Ealing Labour administration: dirty streets, the closure of Ealing Police Station, our declining town centres, and the need to build family style housing rather than tall towers.

Adam vows to use his platform to call out poor decision-making by Ealing Labour throughout his term, and stand up for residents.

Lib Dems and residents demand clean up of Cleveland Park

Lib Dems Councillor Adam Keenan and Mandy Lurie have been working with local residents to collect signatures to improve cleanliness in Cleveland Park.

Cleveland Park is a well-loved and well-used park, yet often bypassed for regular maintenance.

Residents say the park is often full of rubbish and overflowed bins - particularly over summer and school holidays.

The cross-party, resident-led petition has now been submitted to the Mayor of Ealing.

Lib Dem **Councillor Adam Keenan** says, "This petition has received widespread support from local residents."

Councillor Adam Keenan meets Ealing Police chief

Local Lib Dem Councillor Adam Keenan met with Ealing Police Superintendent Sean Lynch to voice his opposition over the Met Police's decision to axe Safer School Officers.

Lib Dem **Councillor Adam Keenan**, who is also an Ealing secondary school teacher serving mainly disadvantaged children, says Safer School Officers are critical both to keep children safe AND to

build long-term trust in the Police amongst young people.

Councillor Adam Keenan told Police Superintendent Sean Lynch that school outreach must be a focus for the long-term safety of our neighbourhoods.

Adam also spoke about residents' concerns of diverting local Safer Neighbourhood Police resources to central London.



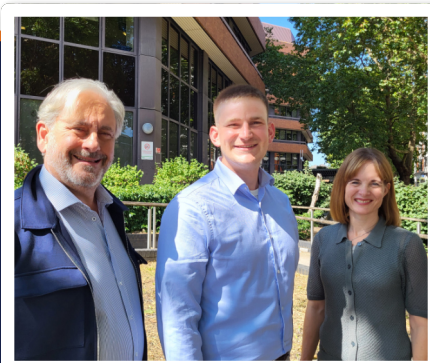

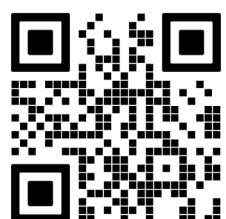
