- 1. Introduce **'Community Skips'**, where the Council supplies free skips periodically to reduce fly-tipping.
- 2. Provide a cheaper and more flexible bulk collection service.
- 3. Remove the current appointmentbased system of the Greenford Recycling Centre and re-open Acton Recycling Centre in its original form.
- **4. Increase recycling bins** in our local high streets.
