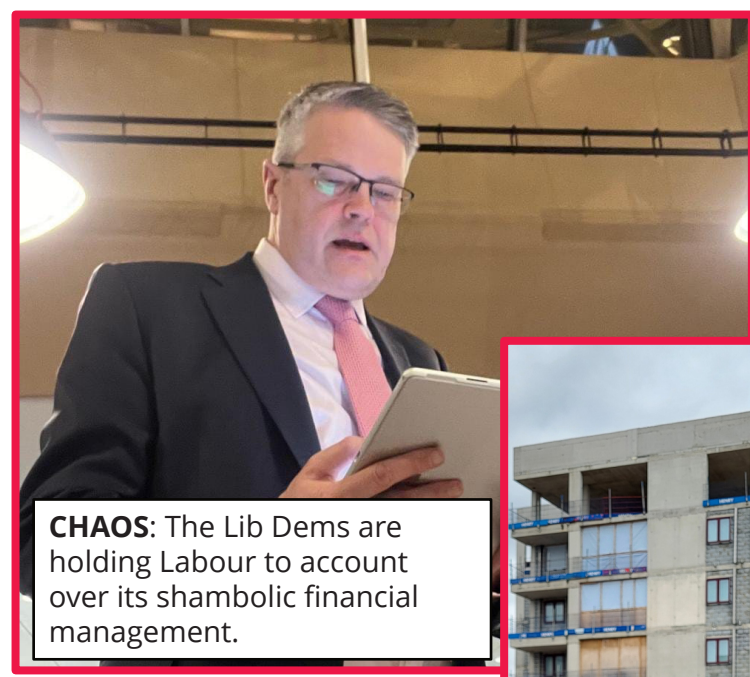
"We will continue to fight for cleaner streets, safer communities, efficient use of your Council Tax, and campaign for people to have a say in local decision-making."

Not again... Labour's £6.5 MILLION housing failure

The Liberal Democrats have uncovered £6.5 MILLION more waste due to Labour's failed attempt to become a property developer.

Broadway Living, the company that Ealing Labour set up, spent £42 MILLION - yet only 180 homes were built out of 1,100 they promised to the Greater London Authority. The company has now gone bust after incurring an obscene **£6.5 MILLION loss** - and the Council now have to knock down half built buildings!

Local **Councillor Jon Ball** slammed Labour on yet another case of chaotic mismanagement of Council finances. He commented, "This failed experiment has a huge cost to local taxpayers - they deserve better."

Lib Dem WIN: Perceval House now available for community use

After years of campaigning by Lib Dem Councillors, Perceval House is now available for local charities and community groups to hire at a discounted rate.

Lib Dem Councillor **Jon Ball** was one of the vocal opponents when a developer attempted to replace Perceval House by a monstrous 26-storey tower block.

Liberal Democrats and local campaigners have long called for Perceval House to be opened up and used as an affordable location for non-profit community events instead.

This was especially important since Ealing Labour decided to shut down the well-used Ealing Town Hall - a space relied on due to its central location and meeting rooms.

Lib Dem Deputy Leader of the Opposition and Communities spokesperson Councillor **Connie Hersch** says, "Liberal Democrats are proud to do our part to support our local community groups."

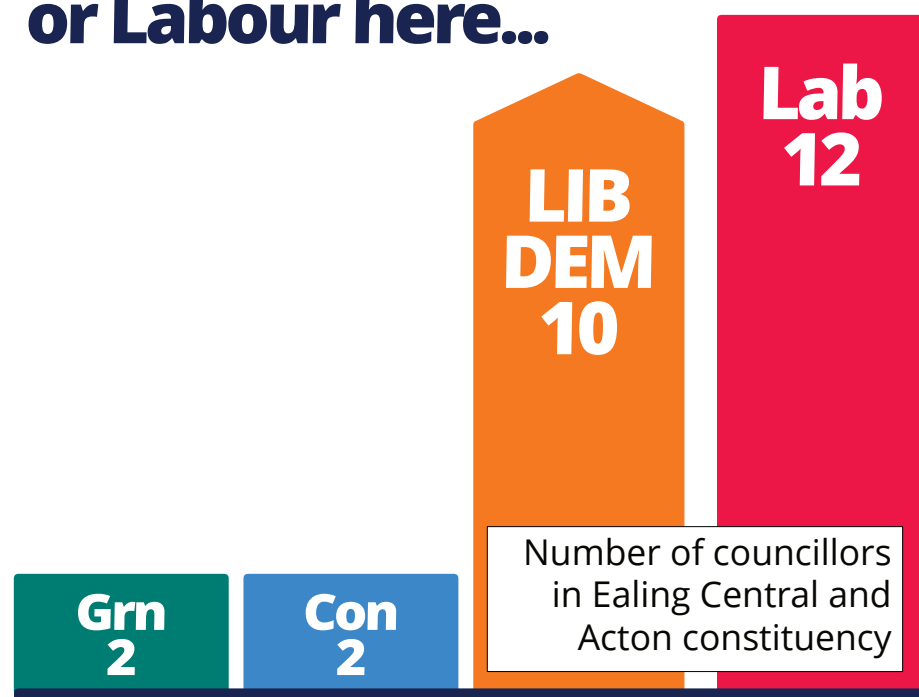
