

## STATION CAR-PARK LATEST

No Decision from Council Committee. Neighbours Face Months of Waiting.

Blackheath Village residents may have to wait until after May's elections for a planning decision on a block of flats proposed for the station car-park.

The controversial plan was expected to be voted on at the February meeting, but councillors voted not to make a decision.

## BELMONT HILL JUNCTION

Lib Dems call on Sadiq Khan to rethink "hazardous" Town Centre crossroads.



Most of us know the junction at Lee Bridge in the Town Centre where Belmont Hill meets Lewis Grove.

This busy crossroads sees multiple bus routes making all kinds of turns. The Lewis Grove side doesn't even have "green man" signals for pedestrians to cross safely.

"This junction is clearly dangerous and needs to

be redesigned," says Lib Dem **Peter Ramrayka**.

"Lewisham Council say they are not responsible, so we will be asking our London Assembly team to raise it with Sadiq Khan and TfL.

"With so much money being spent on Lewisham Town Centre, it makes no sense to leave such a hazardous junction in the middle of it," says **Peter**.
