RULING

- 1. The appeal is dismissed.
- 2. Parties are to make submissions about the publication of this ruling by 4pm on 27th February 2025

BACKGROUND AND REASONING

- 3. This case has been brought by Mark Johnston (in a personal capacity) against the Federal Board claiming that the Board should have submitted various definitions including of 'bullying and harassment' to the Federal Conference under Article 9.9.
- 4. Mark Pack, as President and therefore the Chair of the Federal Board holds that these definitions are not rules as defined by the Article but are a different type of document.
- 5. He points out that this is the sixth time the Board (or its predecessors) has made a decision to adopt or update a document such as this without submitting it to the Federal Conference as it believed it did not come under Article 9.9.
- 6. I find Mark Pack's reasoning to be persuasive and therefore dismiss the Appeal
